short depth of field	Abstraction through short focus, focus on unexpected elements in the photograph, create a series with different parts in focus	hidden and revealed	Having a person or emotion more hidden in the photograph, showing all of a person, reveal everything
color	Saturation of color, desaturation of color, black and white versus, using different filters in black and white to change the value of colors	Femininity	Masculinity
rule of thirds	Pushing the subject to the edges of the frame, centering the subject in a documentary way	Loneliness	Different places that the person is alone in, the person alone within a group of people or a crowd versus just alone.
cropping	Zoom and crop in extreme ways to abstract compositions	Transparency	Explore transparent materials and seeing the person through them - obscure more or less, use shadows and light in addition.

Short	Making them really short or tall	Shy	Completely isolated or entirely surrounded by people.
Young	Making them very young or dressed older than they are	Emotion	Change the facial expression or emotion to match the environment or to be the opposite.
